We encourage support groups, co-ops, and individual homeschooling families to bring cherry pies to Springfield on April 18th to communicate to our legislators that we are proud to have some of the best homeschooling laws in the nation, and we have every intention of keeping them.

This is a FREE event. We still ask that each person/group register so we know how many people and pies we have coming. Watch the **pie thermometer** rise to the top and then overflow! This is a wonderful opportunity for parents to introduce their students to our state's capitol, as well as demonstrate the importance of being involved in the political process.
