Teen Pact

Teenpact is a leadership school that comes to each state's Capitol every year to train students to use their voice to speak up on behalf of those without a voice, to encourage their peers to boldly stand up for truth, and above all, to lift up the name of Jesus unashamedly.

Have you ever seen God do something in your child that you never thought was possible? TeenPact has been one of the most impactful elements of our homeschool journey. None of my children are born leaders, but I've seen God work something remarkable in them and so many others as He has seen fit. I've heard many stories of students with no desire to attend a TeenPact Class who end up completely transformed by the end of the week in Springfield. Everything becomes our mission-field. The students leave with a greater understanding of the processes of law and legislation, butmoreimportantly they leave with an awareness that Jesus wants to affect this culture through their voice, vote, and testimony.

I'm not saying TeenPact will change your child's life, but I do believe that God will change your child's life - and it may happen during a TeenPact week as scripture is shared, as students pray over one another and their legislators, or as clarity comes as to how and why we honor those God has placed in authority over us.

Penguin Ski Club at Hidden Valley (2018-19)

It's an unbelievable price and makes a fantastic Christmas gift!

WHAT IS THE SKI CLUB?

Ski club passes allow one to ski or ride all day once a week for the entire season, which usually runs from mid-December to early March. You can arrive as early as 1:00 PM and ski until closing.

HOW MUCH IS THE SKI CLUB?

For \$129 each person receives a lift ticket and an individual pass.

If you would like to ski on Fridays only, you can buy a Friday pass for \$159. Friday is a high demand day, but still less busy than weekends. NOTE: The same person cannot buy both a Mon-Thurs pass and a Friday pass.

WHAT IS THE DEADLINE TO SIGN-UP AND PAY?

The deadline to join is December 31st at midnight. Hidden Valley makes no exceptions to the deadline.

THIS SOUNDS GREAT! HOW DO I JOIN?

- ◆Go to: https://www.skipeakresorts.com/shophv/ClubLogin
- ♦User name for the club is "Penguins" with a capital P.
- ♦Password is "homeski" with a lower case h.
- ♦Next, click the blue "go shopping."
- ♦At the top left there is a box of categories where you click 18/19 ski passes. Select the pass you would like. Most people want the Mon-Thurs option for \$129. An alternative is to select the Friday only option for \$159 and add it to the cart and check out.
- ◆During check out you will assign a guest for the pass. If you were a member last year, type in the name of each person one at a time and see if it is still in the system. If not, you may need to create a new guest. New members do this by typing in the name, address and birthday, etc.
- ♦Once you find the guest, or create a new one, you select the guest and enter his or her birthday. Check out is like most other things on line. You enter your billing name and address and make payment via Visa, Master Card or Discover.

A NOTE FROM OUR COORDINATORS

When I was a young man and a fairly new Christian, there was a mildly painful lesson I once received from a youth pastor. When I told him an off-color joke, he refused to laugh or show any delight. In fact, he got rather cold about it. Later on he explained that such humor was not for Christians, and that we must be salt and light wherever we go, quoting Ephesians 5:3-4

But among you there must not be even a hint of sexual immorality, or of any kind of impurity, or of greed, because these are improper for God's holy people. Nor should there be obscenity, foolish talk or coarse joking, which are out of place, but rather thanksgiving.

It is certainly a challenge to keep our humor clean, especially since the dirty stuff seems funnier. And yet on social media I see Christians sharing such humor with others. I have always tried to behave like that youth pastor and avoid sharing or even 'liking' such things. I suppose if I were really pure I wouldn't even look at it, but often times the crudeness pops up without warning. We would probably be better off without social media altogether (as many of you know and already practice) and I commend you for that. You're not really missing anything.

So for the rest of us I would like to encourage us all to be like that youth pastor and refuse to share, comment on, or like anything with crudeness or profanity. Let's do our best to clean up our minds and hearts and focus on proper behavior. After all, we want to be continually growing in Christ, not simply staying where we are. If you are on Facebook, I also recommend you download Facebook Purity, which can filter out certain words and advertising. We must be continually growing closer to Christ, so in the words of Aslan from the *Chronicles of Narnia*, "Further up and farther in!"
